

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NIH VACCINE RESEARCH LITIGATION



Cancelled NIH Grants for "Vaccine Hesitancy" and "COVID-related" Research

- > APHA et al. vs. NIH et al.
- Massachusetts et al. vs. Kennedy et al.
 - August 21st Supreme Court 5-4 partial stay of District Court of Massachusetts orders
 - NIH may stop funding contested \$783 million grants until adjudicated in Court of Federal Claims

Jackson's "Calvinball" Dissent

"This is Calvinball jurisprudence with a twist. Calvinball has only one rule: There are no fixed rules. We seem to have two: that one, and this Administration always wins."



Cancelled BARDA Contracts for mRNA Vaccine Research

- \$766 million in H5N1 avian influenza mRNA vaccine research contracts to Moderna terminated on May 28th
- \$500 million terminated on August 5th for 22 mRNA vaccine development investments
- No new mRNA projects will be funded



Entrenching Political Oversight Over Scientific Recommendations

- > EO 14332: Improving Oversight of Federal Grantmaking
 - Grants must be reviewed by senior political appointees to ensure they "demonstrably advance the President's policy priorities."
 - Prohibits peer review recommendations from being "ministerially ratified" or "routinely deferred to."

FEDERAL VACCINE APPROVALS AND RECOMMENDATIONS



Federal Agency Roles

FDA

- Vaccine license approval
- Monitors safety & effectiveness

CDC

 Evidence-based* recommendations for use in age & risk groups

^{*} Prior to June 9, 2025



FDA's COVID Vaccine Booster Approvals

- Approvals for ages 65+ years
- Approvals for ages 5 to 64 years with high-risk underlying medical condition only
- Approvals for ages 6+ months to 4 years with highrisk underlying medical condition only
 - Moderna vaccine only one available for ages 6+ months to 5 years after revoking Pfizer EUA



CDC/ACIP Vaccine Recommendation 2025 Changes

- Only thimerosal-free influenza vaccines
- Removed COVID-19 vaccine recommendation during pregnancy
- No recommendation for 2025-2026 COVID-19 vaccines
